

# What to do with all those TP rolls!

## How About a Pine Cone Owl?

MATERIALS: TP roll, pine cones, glue, acorn tops, (small pliers, wire cutter).

Any size and kind of pine cone works, preferably dry, but wet ones over-wintered work too. Fast-grab glue works just fine especially on a dry and breezy day. Pull or peel back the “scales” with fingers or small tools. Glue onto the TP roll. Mrs. J glued on tiny scales from the tip of the cone, concave side up on the breast, and broader, small scales from the stem end of the cone, for around the eyes. The rest of the body is concave side Down, mixing with up and down as you choose. An immature pine cone makes the beak, though a large scale with pointy end facing down works too – or anything else you might find.
