    - MtA2C vs. Mount A region
      - Mount A region includes Mount A "trail management area" and water district lands
      - Trail management area bordered by Mountain Road, Emery's Bridge Road, Bennett Lot Road, Ogunquit Road, North Village Road, Clay Hill Road, plus proposed 2000' west of Mountain Road to cover connector trail on State land.
  - MDIFW funding historically included support thru Maine Outdoor Heritage Fund. Worth looking into again?
  - Page 7 of draft update: added plans that effect Mt. A.
  - Updated Visitor Use Survey information and data
  - Trends: How things are improving, plus notes on what still needs to be addressed (misuse, opening of trails increased during covid).
  - GWRLT noted sub-committee with mountain bikers and addition of JB.
